The resource person is **Dr. Soumitra Sankar Datta**, *Senior Consultant Psychiatrist* working in the *Department of Palliative Care and Psycho-oncology of Tata Medical Centre*. Soumitra

is a consultant psychiatrist working in Tata Medical Center, Kolkata, India, and holds an honorary dual affiliation with the UCL Institute of Clinical Trials and Methodology, University College London. He is also a lead reviewer with Cochrane Collaboration. His current research touches upon psychological and social aspects of health, decision making, doctor-patient communication, and paediatric psycho-



oncology. Dr. Datta is a research-active clinician and undertook MBBS training in R G Kar Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata. He trained as a psychiatrist in CMC Vellore and subsequently in child and adolescent psychiatry in the United Kingdom. Prior to his current job he worked as a consultant child and adolescent psychiatrist at the Kings College Hospital, London, and the Maudsley Hospital, London. During his clinical career he has trained doctors and other professionals and was an examiner for University of Manchester and Guy's Hospital, London. In 2014, Dr. Datta was awarded the UCL International Teaching Excellence Bursary by the University College London to develop Communication skills training for oncology clinicians. He was also awarded the Donald Cohen Fellowship by the IACAPAP in 2008. Dr. Datta is also a lead reviewer for the Cochrane collaboration and has published several Cochrane reviews. In his spare time, he likes reading and painting, and has conceived the "Art of Medicine" project (https://artofmedicine.in/).
