An introduction to Exploratory Factor Analysis (15, 16 Sept, 2020; 11.30-1.00; $3.30-5.00 \; IST)$ Mousumi Dutta

Factor analysis is a multivariate technique used for data reduction. The basic idea is to represent a set of variables by a smaller number of variables which are called factors. These factors can be thought of as underlying constructs that cannot be measured by a single variable (e.g. happiness). A thorough discussion on theory followed by practical sessions with STATA will enable participants with the backgrounds of economics, statistics, geography, business & commerce and management to apply the knowledge in developing their own research.
