The distribution of marks for internal assessment will be as follows for Generic Elective subjects:

a) For papers with 5+1 credit system: the Internal assessment will be on 20% of the total marks allocated in the paper as per syllabus and subsequent modifications. The mode of the test remains open for the Instructor to decide.

b) For papers with 4+2 credit system: the internal assessment will be on 15% of the total marks allocated in the paper.

Therefore, for **Science** subjects, the marks allotted (15 marks) for the continuous evaluation of the practical / lab work may be treated as Internal assessment, as per the advice of the Dean of Sciences, thereby not opting to take a test for such papers for internal assessment.

1st Semester students of all Science Departments have to mandatorily sit for the **AECC - Environmental Science** examination at their respective Major departments.

For the Humanities students, **AECC English Communication** Examination will be held in their respective major departments while the **Hindi and Bengali AECC** Examinations will be held in their respective AECC departments. For further information, the students shall contact their respective GE/ AECC instructor.
