Submission of abstracts

Abstracts in either pdf, doc or docx format (within 250 words) may be sent by **30th August 2023** midnight IST to **presiecon2019@gmail.com**. The paper may be on any theoretical or empirical issue related to Economics. Please state your name, designation, institutional affiliation, email and contact number. In case of joint papers, the corresponding author should also be identified.

Authors whose papers are selected will be informed by **15th September 2023**. They will have to register for the conference by **15th October 2023**, and submit full papers by **30th November 2023**.
