## LATE PROF. SUBODH KUMAR MUKHOPADHYAY

Subodh Kumar Mukhopadhyay was fairly known in an academic circle all over India and abroad during his lifetime. He was born in 1942 in Bangladesh. He completed his schooling in Bangladesh. He was a medallist in his masters from Calcutta University. He achieved his PhD from Jadavpur University. Dr Mukhopadhyay was Professor of History in West Bengal Senior Education Service. In his early life, he served St. Paul's College, Kolkata, ABN Seal College, Cooch Behar, Chandernagore Government College, Krishnanagar Govt. College, and Presidency College. He retired as Professor and Head of the Department of History, Hooghly Mohsin College, Chinsurah, West Bengal. He had authored many books which are widely appreciated among scholars all over India. He had written several articles in National and International journals. In his lifetime he was a contributor to a series of Cultural Heritage of India published By Ramkrishna Mission, Golpark. He gave several lectures in national and state-level seminars and presided same several times. He had given his scholarly contribution in a Television series on Colonies by the side of river Hooghly made by BBC. He was a profound teacher. He took an effort to upgrade the History Departments of Peripheral Services to postgraduate departments so more students get chances to become established in their life. Till his last breath, he was actively engaged in research, reading and writing.

Mokhopadhyay's single-authored monographs include Adhunik Europ Adiporber Rupantor (1400-1789); Adhunik Purba Asia Chin O Japan (1800-1950); Adimodhya O Modhya Yuge Bharat (600-1556); An introduction to Early Modern Europe 1400-1789: A Political Social Economic and Cultural History; Mughal Empire to British Raj 1556-1818; Evolution of Historiography in Modern India, 1900-1980 A Study of the Writing of Indian History by Her Own Historians; Bāṇlāra ārthika itihāsa, biṇṣśa śatābdī, 1900-1947 (Bengali Edition); Bāṇāli madhyabitta o tāra māṇasaloka (Bengali Edition) and many more.
